



HOW TO MAKE YOUR STAY MORE SUSTAINABLE

We want your stay at Hwest Hotel Hall to be not only comfortable, but also environmentally responsible. Even small actions can help conserve resources and support the region:

- **CONSCIOUS USE OF ENERGY AND WATER**

Please switch off lights, heating or air conditioning when leaving your room, and reuse towels several times before they are changed. Towels are only replaced when you leave them on the floor.

- **WASTE SEPARATION**

Help us separate waste correctly: paper and plastic can be disposed of in the room, residual waste in the bathroom, and additional waste separation (residual waste / plastic / paper) is available in the entrance area.

- **SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY**

Using buses and trains reduces harmful emissions and helps protect the environment. **Hwest Hotel Hall is easily accessible without a car**, and you can explore the entire Hall–Wattens–Innsbruck holiday region without needing one. **Hall-Thaur railway station** is just a short walk from the hotel (450 metres), with **connections to regional and long-distance trains**. Even better: with your guest card, you can use **all regional buses free of charge**. If you arrive by **electric car**, **fast-charging stations** with CCS compatibility are available in the underground garage of Hwest Hotel Hall.

- **REGIONAL PRODUCTS**

We source our breakfast milk from **Tirol Milch**. All **Tirol Milch** products are made from **100% Tyrolean mountain farmers' milk**. Our cheese comes from the **Kolsass dairy**, where all cheeses are produced exclusively from **silage-free hay milk**. Our meat and sausage selection is supplied by the local **Hörtnagl butcher** in Hall, a family-run Tyrolean business. **All meat originates 100% from Tyrol and Austria**. In your room, you will find regional bottled water – and we also invite you to enjoy our tap water, which is high-quality mountain spring water.

- **MINDFUL EVERYDAY HABITS**

Small gestures such as using recycled paper or avoiding single-use products help conserve valuable resources.
